






FSC ECOSYSTEM SERVICES PROCEDURE

- 2. Buy (100% FSC certified) products with associated FSC Ecosystem Services Claims
- 3. Purchase an environmental asset with FSC Claim.

Purchase of products with/ sponsorship of an ecosystem services claim










